A Valentine's Wish

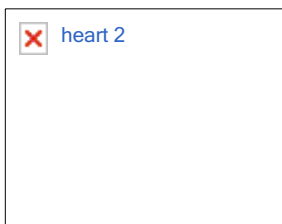


Ever have a Valentine's wish? Maybe some quality chocolate, flowers or even a gourmet dinner at a top flight restaurant you didn't
